Directions: From the East: Mass Pike to (Rte 91 North) to exit 19 (Rte 9) lights at the end of ramp, left onto Rte 9, 1st left Ferry Rd. Fairgrounds on the right. From the West: Rte 91 South (Exit 20) left at the lights, Damon Rd Lights right onto Rte 9 First left onto Ferry Rd. Fairgrounds on the right.

AQHA Novice Performance Horse Halter: Horses must have a Register of Merit (ROM) in the division they are showing in. BRING PROOF when signing up (Ex: A Novice Youth Horse MUST have at least one Youth ROM to go in Novice Youth). Performance Halter and Novice Amateur Horses MUST have at least one ROM in Amateur Competition) Register Of Merit Awards. (ROMs) do not have to have been won by the current person showing the horse. ROM's are on the horse. So if you bought a horse with a ROM in your division, you can show that horse (if you have not pointed out) in either Novice Performance Halter or in regular AQHA Novice Halter. Your choice, you cannot show in both halter classes at the same show. Check your papers for ROM verification or go to www.aqha.com and download your horses' show record and bring it with you.
