(Must Show in Appropriate Halter Class – Novice Amateur and Novice Youth to show in Amateur Halter or Youth Halter This is included in the All Day Fee for Novice)

Approved Lease horses must show an AQHA lease authorization form when making entries

Campers/Trailers with Living Quarters \$ 80.00 No One Day Fee

Motor Homes/ Buses \$100.00 No One Day Fee

Any unit with Living Quarters parked overnight whether using electricity and or water will be charged regardless of where they are parked. Empty Horse Trailers Parked in the Camper Areas will be charged a Camper Fee.

**GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS**  
**FOR ALL MASSQHA FUTURITIES/CHALLENGES/MATURITIES**

The MASSQHA Futurities//Challenges are open to Quarter Horses registered or eligible to be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association unless otherwise stated.  
A percentage of the purse will be held for Office Fee. All decisions will be final.  
The owner of the horse entered must be a 2010 MASSQHA member. Associate type membership is available, (associate membership does not include any MASSQHA privileges after the horse show). One adult parent or legal guardian membership must accompany a youth entry.

No entry fee money will be returned unless class is canceled by Show Committee prior to the beginning of the show. Less than 3 entries will constitute a Futurity canceled. Less than 5 entries the Showmanship Challenge class will be cancelled.  
No substitution of horses once entered except upon written documentation of the death of original horse entered or with approval of Futurity Committee.  
Once entry is received, payment may not be revoked, canceled, refunded or transferred either directly or indirectly. No money may be transferred to another class unless event was canceled prior and approved by show committee.

**PAYBACK INFORMATION**

NOTE: Classes with less than 5 entries, Advertised Money will be half.  
Futurity/Maturity Classes with less than 3 entries will be canceled  
Showmanship Challenge less than 5 entries it will not be held.  
20% will be withheld for office fee in all money added classes.

**\$500 ADDED HUNTER UNDER SADDLE (SUN)**  
**1 Go Round. Also NSBA APPROVED.**
